Md. Ann. Code art. GP, § 4-339 (2014)

§ 4-339. Alarm or security system

(a) In general. -- Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a custodian shall deny inspection of the part of a public record that identifies or contains personal information about a person, including a commercial entity, that maintains an alarm or security system.

(b) Required inspection. -- A custodian shall allow inspection by:

- (1) the person in interest;
- (2) an alarm or security system company if the company can document that it currently provides alarm or security services to the person in interest;
- (3) law enforcement personnel; and
- (4) emergency services personnel, including:
 - (i) a career firefighter;
 - (ii) an emergency medical services provider, as defined in § 13-516 of the Education Article;
 - (iii) a rescue squad employee; and
 - (iv) a volunteer firefighter, a rescue squad member, or an advanced life support unit member.
