### FAQ for Maryland State Police Internship

#### 1. How do I apply for MSP Intern Program?

Students can apply online <a href="https://mdsp.maryland.gov/Careers/Pages/Intern.aspx">https://mdsp.maryland.gov/Careers/Pages/Intern.aspx</a> under the Apply section complete the *Request Form-MSP Student Intern* 

#### 2. Do I get to choose my location for an internship?

You are able to state your preference but all internship opportunities are based on what is available. Where you reside and/or attend school is a considering factor in placement.

# 3. Do I need to be a student enrolled in school to be eligible for an internship?

Our Standard Internship Program accepts active senior high school, college and graduate students. While, the Global Internship Program is open to students, professionals in career transitions and anyone seeking to explore a career path.

#### 4. Is this a paid internship?

No. this is a non-paid internship program.

#### 5. Does this program accept out-of-state or international students?

No. Due to the high volume of in-state applicants the Maryland State Police Internship Programs are not able to accommodate out-of-state or international students.

#### 6. What is the application deadline?

Applications are accepted on a rolling bases, however application submissions do not guarantee placement.

#### 7. Are letters of permission required?

Yes, letters of permission are required for students participating in the Standard Internship Program and must be drafted by an academic advisor/teacher or professor.

#### 8. When will I hear if am selected?

Selections could take approximately three weeks after you submit your application and letter of permission. You will be contacted if you are selected as a candidate and will receive an official letter.

#### 9. Will I be asked to conduct an interview?

Potential candidates may be asked to participate in a phone or virtual interview with a commander or Intern Ambassador prior to intern selection.
