1. I would be able to conduct fixed weighing at assigned weigh stations by observing the scale reading on overweight vehicles and taking appropriate action.

2. I would be able to conduct portable weighing operations anywhere within the assigned area by observing the scale reading on overweight vehicles and taking appropriate action.
