FORENSIC SCIENCES DIVISION COVID-19 RESPONSE

Pursuant to Governor Lawrence Hogan's declaration of a state of emergency in response to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) and his order elevating the Pandemic Flu and Other Infectious Diseases threat to Level II, the Maryland Department of State Police – Forensic Sciences Division has had to make some staffing reductions. However, the Forensic Sciences Division (FSD) remains open and continues to serve the citizens of Maryland and provide forensic services to our customers.

All FSD services are still available. Crime Scene Technicians are responding to crime scenes and Forensic Scientists are analyzing cases. Casework is still being accepted and released by appointment at each of our three laboratories located in Pikesville, Berlin, and Hagerstown.

Please be aware that the availability of appointments for the submission and retrieval of evidence is currently limited due to our reduced staffing.
