Any firearm approved at this meeting will be published in the Maryland Register on December 29, 2023 and, barring no objections, will be included on the Maryland State Police website on January 28, 2024 as a handgun, model and caliber legal for sale in the State of Maryland.

Integrated Mechanical Safety Devices

The Board voted 7-1 to approve Master Lock 90 KEYED Trigger Gun Lock and Mossberg / Regal Industrial Sales R10SC KEYED Cable Gun Lock for addition to their Approved Safety Devices list. Board Member Bajefsky was the dissenting vote due to safety issue. The Maryland Handgun Roster Board approves integrated mechanical safety devices for either factory, distributor, importer aftermarket installation, or by licensed firearms retailers. Installation of any of these listed devices in an approved handgun when sold satisfies Maryland law.
