The Board examined a sample and received an oral and written report from MSP Firearms/Toolmarks Examiner which indicated being functional, but experienced intermittent issues with the breech block not returning to battery in between shots. It occurred for ~ 6 out of 28 shots. Consideration of the firearm was based on the criteria established in Statue; concealability, ballistic accuracy, weight, quality of material, quality of manufacture, reliability as to safety, caliber, detectability and utility for legitimate sporting activities, self-protection or law enforcement.

The Board voted 6-3 to table the firearm in all the above-mentioned calibers as it fails to meet the criteria stated in statute. Board Members Crifasi, Dennis, and Kohn were the dissenting votes.
