Dear Fire Chief:

Our office would like to provide you with information about the upcoming transition to the National Emergency Response Information System (NERIS), a new platform designed to modernize incident reporting and enhance data analysis capabilities for fire departments across the United States. The Maryland Office of the State Fire Marshal will work side-by-side with the NERIS team to ensure the transition within the State of Maryland occurs quickly and efficiently.

NFRIS will no longer be accessible as of January 2026 and NERIS expects a full transition no later than December 31, 2025. We encourage your department to actively engage in the NERIS transition process to ensure a smooth transition and maximize the benefits of this new system.

Over the next couple of months, my office will be facilitating informational sessions across the state.
